Broadly, traditional solid soap bars tend to be made from a combination of fat or oil, water and an alkali substance such as lye. Liquid soap, or hand wash, is made from synthetic detergents, such as sodium lauryl ether sulfate, instead. Ideally, choose one with moisturising agents, as this will help to offset frequent hand washing.
